What

Callery Pear and Honeysuckle are quickly taking over the wooded areas of Kingswood North.

Volunteers will be hand sawing/trimming small invasive woody plants and trees, then dragging to the chipper area. Once removed there will be room again for local wildflowers, grasses, and trees to spread and thrive. Those under 18 must be accompanied by a legal guardian.

Join us as we remove harmful invasive honeysuckle and pear trees!
